The plan proposes absorbing the commissions and boards into existing or new state agencies or in some instances completely eliminating them. There are a total of 94 boards and commissions on the list. Some to be absorbed include Building Standards Commission, Court Reporters Board of California, Dental Board of California, Industrial Welfare Commission, Medical Board of California, Occupational Safety and Health Appeal Board, Postsecondary Education Commission, Public Library Construction and Renovation Board, Unemployment Insurance Appeals Board and the Workers' Compensation Appeals Board. The Commission on Uniform State Laws is slated for complete elimination.
